ABOUT BCOC

BCOC is designed to equip officer candidates and junior officers with the knowledge, skills, and attitudes that correspond to their command and staff duties in CAP.

The course has four areas of concentration:

- Organizational and Program Overviews
- Project Management Concepts and Skills
- Leadership Styles and Principles
- Professional Military Education and Enrichment

As part of the course, participants work together to as a "cadet staff" of a fictitious squadron to develop a program plan for a calendar year, in which they apply the skills they learned and share the activities and programs that they currently implement in their respective knowledge.

This course is a real plus if you want to apply to be a staff member of wing level cadet activities like Cadet Encampment.

TO APPLY

Students: Complete either the online or paper application form. The paper form can be obtained at your unit. The online application is at the website www.mnwg.cap.gov/cp/mla02 Please review the course description and make sure that you meet the standards. Applicants must have graduated from an encampment and NCOS. (NCOS does not apply to non MN Wing Cadets and may be waived on a case by case basis for MN Wing Cadets) Applicants must also be in the grade of at least C/SMSgt.
