

NCOS 2002 Fact Sheet

NCOS is the second step in the Integrated Leadership Program (ILP). Its purpose is to give students the academic background for being an effective NCO along with the all-important PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE. It also serves as an opportunity to standardize drill and ceremonies.

The school is developed to be of benefit to both the experienced and in-experienced Cadet NCO. For the newer/in-experienced NCO, they will have the chance to learn about leading and managing others, speaking in front of groups, and will be able to drill the flight under the direction of the NCOS staff.

The experienced NCO will be allowed to further refine their skills in management and leadership, and will be an in-valuable resource to the in-experienced students in their "seminar" group. No matter what your experience level, if you have not attended an NCOS previously, there is a TREMENDOUS opportunity that awaits you.

The growth you experience will not only benefit you, but your ENTIRE UNIT as well. Additionally, if your goal is to be on encampment staff, having attended an NCOS will weigh heavily in your favor.

Prerequisites

- Students must be the grade of C/A1C or higher.
- Students must have attended Cadet Encampment or the Airman Training School as a basic cadet.

The 2002 NCOS **IS ACCEPTING STUDENT APPLICATIONS** at this time. The dates for the NCOS are 17-20 October 2001. Applications will be accepted in paper and electronic forms for staff and students. Please check our website for more information.

On Thursday 17 Oct, in-processing will begin in the early evening. Training is scheduled to conclude Sunday Afternoon with Graduation. Specific times will be posted as they become available.

The cost per student has been set at \$35.00 and there is a class size limit of 40. Please make checks/money orders payable to Minnesota Wing CAP (put NCOS in the "memo" section of the check please). Do NOT send cash. Applicants must include their activity fee with their application
