MEMBER RECEIVES AWARD

Breezy Point, MN – Major Andrew Browning received Minnesota Wing’s Historian Specialist of the Year Award during a ceremony on May 4th. Major Browning is a member of Red Wing Squadron that meets Thursday Nights at Red Wing Airport.

The Historian Specialist Award recognizes an officer who insures that all historical records and artifacts of a unit are in proper order and provides excellent customer service to the members of his or her unit. It also recognizes the officer’s expertise in the completion an annual history for a unit. This history tells the story of the squadron and is kept in the unit’s permanent records.

Major Browning received his award at the 2002 Minnesota Wing Conference, held at Breezy Point Resort 3-5 May.

Major Browning is very active in the Civil Air Patrol. He is an active Ground Search and Rescue Team Leader, trainer and leader in the Cadet Program.

Civil Air Patrol, the official U. S. Air Force Auxiliary, is a civilian, volunteer, nonprofit, service organization. The unpaid members perform more than 85 percent of inland search and rescue missions as tasked by the Air Force Rescue and Coordination Center.
